TALK IT OVER

KEY SCRIPTURE:

Romans 8:14-19

14 For all who are led by the Spirit of God are children[g] of God. 15 So you have not received a spirit that makes you fearful slaves. Instead, you received God's Spirit when he adopted you as his own children.[h] Now we call him, "Abba, Father."[i] **16** For his Spirit joins with our spirit to affirm that we are God's children. 17 And since we are his children, we are his heirs. In fact, together with Christ we are heirs of God's glory. But if we are to share his glory, we must also share his suffering. 18 Yet what we suffer now is nothing compared to the glory he will reveal to us later. 19 For all creation is waiting eagerly for that future day when God will reveal who his children really are.

Start thinking. Ask a question to get your group thinking.

- What are we trying to accomplish in this Theologian series?
- Why is a unique series like Theologian important for us as Christians today?
- Pastor Jeff made mention of choosing to strategically have a "chit chat" today instead of a
 "proper sermon." What are some major differences between a "proper sermon" and a "chit
 chat?" Why is it important to only veer away from a proper sermon on extremely rare
 occasions in congregational worship? Why was it appropriate to veer away from the norm
 for this special Sunday?

Note: this question can get out of control if you have a very zealous traditionalist in your group. The question is meant to help the group examine their ecclesiological view of a sermon within a congregational setting. Guard your group to be careful, respectful, and have fun with this one!

Start sharing. Choose a question to create openness.
