Jesus Appears to Disciples

(John 20:19-31)

Week 1

Brite Idea: Jesus can be trusted.

He Question: How did Jesus show He could be trusted?

Jesus had told His disciples that He would die but would be raised back to life again. And He was! He met the disciples face-to-face to show them He was alive.

We Question: What should we do when we doubt?

God is patient with our doubts. We can talk to Him about them and ask for His help. We can also talk to a trusted adult who loves Jesus.

Jesus Ascends

(Acts 1:1-11)

Week 2

Brite Idea: Jesus is in heaven and will return.

He Question: Why did Jesus return to heaven?

Jesus said He had to return to prepare a place for us and so that the Holy Spirit could come. Jesus now sits at the right hand of God the Father. One day He will return and make all things new.

We Question: What will happen to us when we die?

If we trust in Jesus as our Savior, we will live forever with Him. Heaven is a perfect place with no pain and no tears. We will be with God and worship Him forever.

Pentecost

(Acts 2:1-41)

Week 3

Brite Idea: The Holy Spirit lives inside followers of Jesus.

He Question: Who is the Holy Spirit?

There is one God. He is also three distinct persons, the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit is God and dwells within believers.

We Question: How does the Holy Spirit help us?

When we trust in Jesus as Lord and Savior, the Holy Spirit comes to live in us. The Holy Spirit convicts us of sin, guides us to truth in God's Word and glorifies God.

(Acts 6 & 7)

Week 4

Brite Idea: God is for us when the world is not.

He Question: Does God care about what is happening on

Earth?

— God cares deeply about His creation, especially His people. Because our world was broken by sin, bad things happen but nothing is outside of His control. God uses everything for His glory. We Question: What can we do when it feels like the world is against us?

We can focus on Jesus. He loves us and is with us no matter what. He gives us strength and wisdom for all we face.

| WEEK 4 | READ TOGETHER: John 16:33 When we face trouble, what can we be sure of? | Build a block tower. With each block, list how God is for us. Talk about how God's love is eternal. | ROMANS 8:31B How do we know God is really for us? | Draw a heart and write ways you can "take heart" this week by knowing that God is for us even when the world is not. | Share how you have each changed in the last year. READ TOGETHER: Luke 23:26-24:12 DISCUSS: What does this teach us about God? |
