

**SCRIPTURE AND
KEY SERMON NOTES:**

5 In your relationships with one another, have the same mindset as Christ Jesus: 6 Who, being in very nature God, did not consider equality with God something to be used to his own advantage;v7 rather, he made himself nothing by taking the very nature of a servant, being made in human likeness. 8 And being found in appearance as a man, he humbled himself by becoming obedient to death— even death on a cross! 9 Therefore God exalted him to the highest place and gave him the name that is above every name, 10 that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, 11 and every tongue acknowledge that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father. Philippians 2:5-11 NIV

THE COMMAND: HAVE THE MINDSET OF JESUS

5 Traits of Jesus mindset
JESUS MINDSET WAS SURRENDERING TO GOD'S WILL

JESUS SHOWED UP

JESUS Poured HIMSELF OUT

JESUS MADE THE ULTIMATE SACRIFICE

GOD EXALTED HIM WHAT MINDSET DO YOU HAVE?

"Here I am , I have come to do your will." Hebrews 10:9

START PRAYING:

Father in Heaven, thank you for loving us. Thank you for sending your Son to Earth and to the cross for our sins. Thank you for conquering the grave for us. Thank you for calling us to Christlikeness! Help us to live in that calling, now, today, and forever, in Jesus' name, amen!.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

START TALKING:

What's a mindset or attitude that has really shaped how you live? How did you develop it?

When you think of someone with a Christlike mindset, who comes to mind? What about them stands out?

START THINKING:

Read **Philippians 2:5-11** together. What stands out to you most in this passage?

Philippians 2:5 commands us to have the **same mindset as Jesus**. What does that practically look like for us in daily life?

Look at the five traits of Jesus' mindset from the sermon: 1) **Surrendering to God's will**, 2) **Showing up**, 3) **Pouring Himself out**, 4) **Making the ultimate sacrifice**, 5) **God exalting Him**

Which of these is the most challenging for you? Why?

Read **Hebrews 10:9** - "Here I am, I have come to do your will." What does this tell us about Jesus' obedience? How does this apply to us?

START SHARING:

Showing Up: Jesus was present for people. Where is God calling you to be more present - in your relationships, church, or community?

Jesus embraced **humility and obedience** even when it led to suffering. What are some ways God is calling you to trust Him even when obedience is difficult?

Paul commands us to have the **same mindset as Christ** in our relationships with others (Philippians 2:5). How can we live that out practically in our church, family, or workplace?

Share a time when you felt prompted to surrender something to God but hesitated. What happened? What would it look like to fully surrender it now?

How does God's exalting of Jesus give us hope when we are called to humility and sacrifice?

START DOING:

Identify One Trait: Choose one of the five traits of Jesus' mindset and focus on applying it this week.
