KEY SCRIPTURE:

Start Talking. Find a conversation starter for your group.

• What part of your childhood was most impactful on your faith?

Start Thinking. Ask a question to get your group thinking.

- What are some important differences between the Deuteronomy 6 audience and modern Christians?
- Even though we are in the covenant of grace and not under the Law, why is the Sh'ma (vv. 4-9) a helpful and relevant teaching and prayer for the modern Christian?
- What is the main point being made in the Sh'ma?

Start Sharing. Choose a question to create openness.

- While the heart of the message in Deut 6 is focused on living a life centered around Jesus, there are many potential distractions in life. Taking this idea a step farther, Pastor Jeff noted that "good things may distract people in bad ways."
 Good, bad, or otherwise, what is a recent distraction from your relationship with God that you have overcome?
- What is the biggest distraction you are battling right now?
- What are some of the most meaningful things you've seen or witnessed, as a
 parent yourself or a parent you know, where someone gradually transferred
 dependence on the parent into dependence on God over time?
- Check the chip on your shoulder. This was not the main point of the sermon or the text, but it is a meaningful conversation for most people to have. Is there a chip on your shoulder that would be meaningful to share with your Gospel Community?

Start Praying. Pray this prayer in your own words with your group.

Dear Heavenly Father, thank you for loving us as the perfect parent, for modeling for us how we may love our own kids and one another. We take this time to pray for the orphan and widow, a special group of people you've given us an extra responsibility to care for. We pray for our kids and the future generations, that we may pave a way for them to reach everyone we didn't get to, in Your name, amen!

Start Doing. Commit to a step and live it out this week.

 Do not try to fix every. Single. Thing. At once right now. Find and commit to one healthy step forward in loving God with all your heart, mind, soul, and strength and leading other toward that intentionally.
