*“The twenty-four elders fall down and worship the one sitting on the throne (the one who lives forever and ever). And they lay their crowns before the throne and say, “You are worthy, O Lord our God, to receive glory and honor and power. For you created all things, and they exist because you created what you pleased.””**Revelation 4:10-11 NLT***

“I appeal to you therefore, brothers, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and acceptable to God, which is your spiritual worship.”  
**Romans 12:1 ESV**

*“No one can serve two masters. Either you will hate the one and love the other, or you will be devoted to the one and despise the other. You cannot serve both God and money.” **Matthew 6:24 NIV***

**WEAPONIZE YOUR WORSHIP!**

**CONSTANTLY \_\_\_\_\_ WORSHIP**

Worship is a continual choice, especially in challenging moments. It’s easy to worship when life is smooth, but true worship is choosing to praise God even when things are difficult and not forgetting to worship when things go well for a long period of time.

**USE THE WORD AS A \_\_\_\_\_**

God’s Word should be central to worship. Singing Scripture, declaring God’s promises, and meditating on His truth strengthen our worship and equip us in spiritual battles.

*“And take... the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God.” **Ephesians 6:17***

*“But he answered, ‘It is written, Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that comes from the mouth of God.’” **Matthew 4:4***

*“Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light to my path.” **Psalm 119:105***

**WORSHIP IN \_\_\_\_\_**

Worship is powerful when done in community. There is a collective strength in worshipping together, and corporate worship serves as a public declaration of God’s glory and victory.
