KEY SERMON NOTES:**

**CORE VALUE: PEOPLE REACHING**

We believe the gospel saves people's souls and transforms their lives. And if we believe that, how can we keep it to ourselves? If everyone tries to reach everyone, we may reach **every one!** We will share the gospel; we will share stories of god working in our lives; and we will Live like Jesus in a way that inspires people to believe in him because they see him in us and hear his truth through us!

**SHARING JESUS HELPS YOU  
FLOURISH.**

*"Come, see a man who told me everything I ever did. Could this be the Messiah?" John 4:29 (NIV)*

**LEARN TO SHARE JESUS  
FROM THE WOMAN AT THE WELL:**

1. **LET JESUS LOVE YOU** III *John 4:9-15*
2. **TAKE NOTE OF HOW JESUS TRANSFORMS YOU** III *John 4:11-12, 16-17, 19-21*
3. **TELL YOUR JESUS STORIES TO WHOEVER WILL LISTEN** III *John 4:28-30 &*
4. **DON'T FORGET "THE GOSPEL."**

**START PRAYING:**

Lord Jesus, thank you for the amazing ways you have and continue to work in my life and the lives of those around me. Help me to find joy in you, and to see you working in my life today. If you're sending me through a season of refining and growth, thank you for the discomfort you'll use to grow me. If you're sending me into a season of rest and rejuvenation, help me to not get complacent there, but draw me closer to You. Use every season of my life to do just that, to bring me closer to you and to use me to bring others closer to You as well. In Jesus' name, amen!

**START TALKING:**

What is a cand, snack, treat that you cannot say "no" to?!

**START THINKING:**

Read John 4:1-43 as a group.

**Most things in life diminish when we share them (money, food, time). But what are some things that actually increase when we share them?** (e.g., love, joy, encouragement, faith)

**Jesus took an intentional detour through Samaria, a place Jews avoided.**

- What does this tell us about Jesus' mission?
- How does this challenge us to go outside our comfort zones to share our faith?

**The woman at the well came at noon to avoid people.**

- What are some reasons people today avoid God, church, or spiritual conversations?
- Have you ever avoided an opportunity to share your faith? Why?

**Jesus engaged in conversation with the Samaritan woman despite cultural and social barriers.**

- What are some modern-day "barriers" that keep us from sharing Jesus with others?
- How can we break down those barriers in love?

**START SHARING:**

**Jesus knew everything about the woman, yet He still pursued her.**

- Have you ever felt "too far gone" or "too broken" for God's love?
- How did you come to experience His grace despite your past?

**The woman at the well left her water jar behind and ran to tell others.**

- What "water jars" (priorities, distractions, fears) hold us back from sharing Jesus?
- What would it look like for you to leave something behind to follow Jesus more fully?

**Your personal story is powerful!**

- What's a time when Jesus transformed an area of your life?
- How could you share that story in a way that points others to Him?

**Jesus didn't give her a scripted evangelism technique—He simply met her where she was.**

- How can we make faith-sharing more natural in our daily lives instead of seeing it as a "sales pitch"?

**The disciples went into town but brought back no one. The woman went into town and brought back a crowd.**

- Why do you think new believers often share their faith more boldly than seasoned Christians?
- How can we regain that passion and boldness in our faith?

**START DOING:**

Get a pen, paper, and/or a whiteboard and spend 30-45 minutes thinking through the major moments or changes in your life that God has used to transform you and your life. How can you share those moments as "Jesus stories?"

Make a list of people to talk to about Jesus. Set some goals to get it done!
